Fellow ANEW Members,

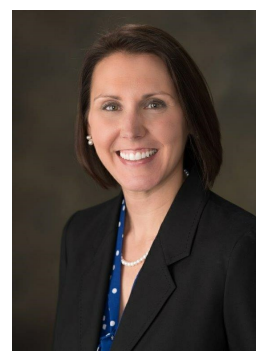

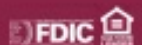
