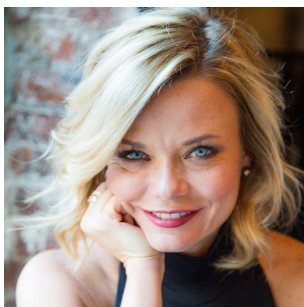

Our Deepest Sympathy- Sylvia Weinzapfel

It has been nearly 37 years, since Sylvia Weinzapfel and Nan Francis first discussed the need for a professional women's network in Evansville. Less than six months after their first discussion, the first meeting for ANEW was held. While this organization has evolved and many women have grown both professionally and personally through ANEW, the basic purpose, as envisioned by Sylvia and Nan, has not changed.



One of ANEW's founders, Sylvia Weinzapfel, passed away in late July at the age of 81. She will be remembered for her lifelong push for social justice, racial and gender equality and for the many causes she championed in her lifetime.

She worked as the assistant director of continuing education at USI, is credited with helping bring the CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) program to Vanderburgh County and started the transitional housing program for homeless women recovering from substance abuse and an after school program for at-risk girls at the YWCA. Some of Sylvia's other interests included: League of Women Voters, United Way and other community arts and educational organizations. She worked on many projects aimed at preserving and sharing the history of women in Evansville.

In her final days, Sylvia left her grandkids with one last piece of advice, "Go out and change the world."

That advice resonates in the purpose of ANEW. While we are not her grandchildren, we benefit from the positive effects of her legacy. Sylvia
