- Approximately 6.9 million Americans currently live with Alzheimer’s dementia. This equates to 1 in 9 Americans 65+. Two-thirds of this population living with Alzheimer’s dementia, or 4.2 million, are women.

- Family members are heavily involved with caregiving. At least 11 million Americans provide nearly \$350 billion in unpaid caregiving services annually.
