### 1. Describe your career path to reach your current position.

My position as Founder & CEO of Chemo Buddies came about as a result of my sister Karen being diagnosed with metastatic Triple Negative Breast Cancer. We knew there would be no cure for Karen, but we were going to do everything we could to make life as good as it could be in the time she had left. The chemo room, while beautiful, was quiet and sterile. (We got in some trouble along the way to 'quiet down', we laughed ALOT and made the long treatment day as pleasant as possible. While sitting in the treatment room, we wrote a proposal for Chemo Buddies - to bring volunteers into the treatment room so that no one would ever have to go through chemo alone. Three weeks after Karen passed away, I founded Chemo Buddies as a legacy to her love and laughter.

**2. My greatest achievement personally** was raising an amazing daughter who creates goodness in the world through teaching 3rd graders at McCutchanville. She is a true light. My greatest professional achievement is pioneering a movement of hospitals allowing volunteers into the chemo room. We now serve in every outpatient facility in Evansville and Henderson.

What part of your job is most satisfying? When patients tell me how much their Chemo Buddy helped them through chemo, I think of it as Karen smiling down on us.

**3. I would love to vacation** anywhere where I can sit in the sun and listen to the ocean. It's not about the tan, it's about appreciating the magnificance of God and restoring my soul.

**4. What is your most relaxing habit?** Crafting with my Cricut.

**5. What is your favorite thing about being an ANEW member?** Meeting other women who understand the joys and cost of success.
